Position: Clinician **Reports to:** Clinical Director **Hours:** Non-exempt revenue based position, up to 40 client hours per week

Description: Responsible for intake assessment, treatment planning, and implementation of adventure therapy, outdoor behavioral healthcare, nature therapy, and/or office-based talk therapy sessions. Additionally responsible for maintaining a relationship as an effective team member and maintaining collaborative relationships with the community.

Core Competencies:

1. Master's or Doctoral Degree in a Mental Health related area.
2. State of Illinois LCPC, LMFT, LCSW, PHD, or PsyD
3. Ability to build meaningful relationships with clients, clients' families, AW team members, collaborators, and referral sources
4. Experience and confidence identifying, implementing, and assessing evidence based practices.
5. Experience working with individuals, families, and groups of all ages.
6. Experience and/or training in adventure therapy or related modalities.
7. Ability to work flexible hours.
8. Ability to organize tasks independently and effectively, and manage time.
9. Strong written and oral communication skills.
10. Proficiency with a computer and basic software along with use of various social networks and AW website.
11. Willingness to adopt, promote, and improve on AW's mission and agency culture.
12. Work through a multiculturally sensitive and trauma sensitive lens.
13. Physically capable of performing adventure based activities unassisted or with reasonable accommodations.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Perform assessments and intakes
2. Develop treatment plans
3. Conduct individual, family, and group therapy sessions as indicated in assessment and treatment plan
4. Consult with ancillary treatment providers as needed
5. Write case notes in a timely manner and maintain organized case files
 - a. Case notes for weekday groups will be recorded in client's electronic and paper files by 5:00 PM on the Friday following each group
 - b. Case notes for weekend groups will be recorded in client's electronic and paper files by 5:00 PM on the Tuesday following the weekend groups
6. Maintain continuing education credits according to professional licensing requirements
7. Seek clinical and programmatic supervision as needed from the clinical director. If unable to provide expertise needed, discuss with clinical or executive director for further consultation
8. Consider oneself an ambassador for Adventure Works
9. Engage in active referral development.
10. Represent self in a professional manner within and outside of the agency
